There were also these this week: Building Fund (3/31) \$910.00; Candle Donations \$971.00; Nocturnal Adoration \$236.00; For the Poor \$200.00.

General Fund available funds for operating Church and School = **\$18,273.37** as of 4/4/19. We owe **\$1,920.80** Regular Bills next week, and we are behind **\$26,826.99** to the Diocese for our March/Prev. Unpaid Health Ins. expenses; **Net Deficit = \$10,474.42**. We did get the matching grant money from the (anonymous) Foundation thanks to their generosity and your donations to our appeal back in January. The check for \$62,500 came last week and \$6,000 of the total \$125,000 raised was used to reduce our debt to the Diocese of Lincoln and the remaining \$99,000 is now set aside to update and preserve our old parish hall and gym in the local

construction account. Here are some things we are billed for each month: Payroll \$27,000, which includes monthly salary for Fr. Major \$1,800; Fr. Daro's is \$1,650.; Diocese Bill \$9,350 (it includes our share of salaries of priests that work in the Chancery, retirement payments for two priests @633/month and other items). With the payment mentioned above we are just two months behind now. We also owe \$18,000 in health insurance premiums that weren't billed to us until recently. Our monthly invoice clearly says we are on the hook for such a thing because we are responsible for knowing how much we owe. ☹ Other items include 4.5 School Sisters' monthly salary \$9,600; Missalettes \$138.00; Copier \$110.00.
