UNBOUND MINISTRIES is a deliverance prayer ministry that focuses on people, not on evil spirits. Unbound is a safe, loving and reproducible model that helps people respond to the good news of the gospel and apply the truth to their lives using the five keys. Unbound Ministry is based on the idea that the gospel has the power to make a difference in a person's life. It is a way of prayer that empowers a person to open their hearts and respond more fully to Jesus's invitation of abundant life. Unbound is essentially moving a person through a conversion experience. The five keys are: 1. Repenting of sin and expressing faith in Jesus. 2. Forgiving oneself and others. 3. Renouncing the lies, spirits, and tactics of Satan. 4. Taking authority over the works of Satan. 5. Receiving the Father's blessing. The Diocese of Lincoln's Unbound Ministry is hosting a **2-day Unbound Conference on August 24th and 25th**. The conference will take place in Lincoln at the John XXIII Diocesan Center and goes from 6-9PM on Friday the 24th and from 8AM- 5PM on Saturday the 25th. A few of the presentations include: *Freedom in Christ, The Power of Forgiveness, and Staying Free: The Battle of the Mind*. HEARING JESUS' KNOCK In his June 2009 encyclical *Caritas in Veritate*, Pope Benedict XVI reminds the world that poverty will not be eradicated unless we rediscover and protect the sanctity of life at every level. Dismissing the unborn as less than human and allowing abortion impedes the work of social justice. He points out with urgency, "While the poor of the world continue knocking on the doors of the rich, the world of affluence runs the risk of no longer hearing those knocks, on account of a conscience that can no longer distinguish what is human" (n. 75). **EL QUE BUSA ES CRISTO** *En la Encíclica Caritas in Veritate de Junio del 2009, el Papa Benedicto XVI recuerda al mundo que la pobreza no será erradicada a menos que descubramos y protejamos la santidad de la vida a todos los niveles. Él señala con urgencia, "Mientras los pobres del mundo siguen llamando a la puerta de la opulencia, el mundo rico corre el riesgo de no escuchar ya estos golpes a su puerta, debido a una conciencia incapaz de reconocer lo humano" (n75).*
