We asked the foundation for help catching up on three specific expenses but this appeal to the parish focuses on one of them: Fire Marshall Ordered us to fix deficiencies in the gym and our old hall that add up to at least \$64,000. After our new hall was done last summer the Fire Marshall inspected the older part of the building and came up with this list for our safety. We will conclude the appeal on January 31st, 2019.
