In 1973, the **SUPREME COURT'S DOE VS. BOLTON DECISION** was the companion case to Roe vs. Wade, making abortion legal throughout pregnancy. Sandra Cano, the "Mary Doe" plaintiff of Doe vs. Bolton, technically won the case and the right to have an abortion – except that she never wanted one. Sandra was always a pro-life Christian until her death in 2014. On March 23, 1997, she declared these memorable words: "I am Sandra Cano. I became known as Mary Doe when the U.S. Supreme Court released Doe v. Bolton, which allowed abortion for virtually any reason. I am against abortion; I never sought an abortion; I have never had an abortion. Abortion is murder. For over twenty years, and against my will, my name has been synonymous with abortion. The Doe v.

Bolton case is based on deceit and fraud. I stand today in this place of healing, the National Memorial for the Unborn, and pledge to the memory of these innocent children, that as long as I have breath, I will strive to see abortion ended in America."

En 1973, **LA DECISIÓN DOE VS. BOLTON DE LA CORTE SUPREMA**, caso compañero de Roe vs. Wade, hizo el aborto legal durante el embarazo. Sandra Cano, la demandante "María Doe" de Doe vs. Bolton, técnicamente ganó el caso y el derecho a tener un aborto -excepto que ella nunca quiso uno. Sandra siempre fue una cristiana pro-vida hasta su muerte en 2014. El 23 de marzo de 1997, declaró estas memorables palabras: "Soy Sandra Cano. Me hice conocida como María Doe cuando la Corte Suprema de Estados Unidos lanzó Doe vs. Bolton, que permitió el aborto por prácticamente cualquier razón. Estoy en contra del aborto; Nunca busqué un aborto; Nunca he tenido un aborto. El aborto es asesinato. Por más de veinte años, y en contra de mi voluntad, mi nombre ha sido sinónimo de aborto. El caso Doe v. Bolton se basa en el engaño y el fraude. Yo estoy hoy en este lugar de sanación, el Memorial Nacional de los No Nacidos, y me comprometo con la memoria de estos niños inocentes, que mientras tenga aliento, me esforzaré para buscar el fin del aborto en Estados Unidos".
