It has led us to a challenge, and it's going extremely well so far: some \$51,000 has been given. We asked the foundation for help catching up on three specific expenses but this appeal to the parish focuses on one of them: Fire Marshall Ordered us to fix deficiencies in the gym and our old hall that add up to at least \$64,000. After our new hall was done last summer the Fire Marshall inspected the older part of the building and came up with this list for our safety. If you would like to be part of this effort before year's end please be sure to write a date bearing the year 2018 and turn it in on time for tax purposes. We will conclude the appeal on January 31st, 2019. If there are leftover funds or late donations generated by this campaign they will be deposited to the construction bank account we still use for our future church.
