The proclamation of the date of Easter and the other moveable feasts on **EPHANY** dates from a time when calendars were not readily available. It was necessary to make known the date of Easter in advance, since many celebrations of the liturgical year depend on its date. The number of Sundays that follow Epiphany, the date of Ash Wednesday, and the number of Sundays that follow Pentecost are all computed in relation to Easter. Although calendars now give the date of Easter and the other feasts in the liturgical year for many years in advance, the Epiphany proclamation still has value. It is a reminder of the centrality of the resurrection of the Lord in the liturgical year and the importance of the great mysteries of faith which are celebrated each year. Starred dates are holy days of obligation. *La proclamación de la fecha de Pascua y las otras fiestas movibles en **EPIFANÍA** data de una época en que los calendarios no estaban disponibles. Era necesario dar a conocer la fecha de Pascua de antemano, ya que muchas celebraciones del año litúrgico dependen de su fecha. El número de domingos que siguen a Epifanía, la fecha del Miércoles de Ceniza y el número de domingos que siguen a Pentecostés se computan en relación con la Pascua. Aunque los calendarios ahora dan la fecha de Pascua y las otras fiestas en el año litúrgico por muchos años de anticipación, la proclamación de la Epifanía todavía tiene valor. Es un recordatorio de la centralidad de la resurrección del Señor en el año litúrgico y la importancia de los grandes misterios de la fe que se celebran cada año. Días de obligación se indican por el *.*
