LENT AND LIFE Anyone who makes the Lenten journey is called to be more alert to the attacks on human life and dignity around them. The people of life are called to reject sin and all the devil's works and empty promises (-from the renewal of Baptismal Promises at Easter). The "pro-choice" and "right to die" mentalities are two of those "empty promises" which are firmly rejected by the baptized. A firm rejection of these positions is integral to repentance. Lent is the perfect time for us to gain a clearer understanding of why this is true, and to lead them to a deeper affirmation of life, both natural and eternal, in the celebration of the Paschal Mystery.

La Cuaresma es el tiempo perfecto para que llamemos a nuestras congregaciones a un entendimiento más claro de por qué esto es verdad, y de llevarlos hacia una afirmación más profunda de la vida, tanto natural como eterna, en la celebración del Misterio Pascual.*
