**LENTEN REGULATIONS: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**—these are serious obligations:

Ash Wednesday fast **and** eat no meat

Six Fridays in Lent: no meat, (including hot dogs @ bball games)

Good Friday fast **and** eat no meat

**Fasting** means eating two smaller meals and one full meal with. No snacks or eating between meals allowed—that's for healthy Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. **Abstinence** means eating no meat nor soup nor gravy made from meat; that's for healthy Catholics over the age of 14. Exceptions: sickness, hard manual labor, pregnancy, etc., automatically excuse a person from these obligations. In cases of doubt or question, the priest who hears a person's confession should be consulted.

Men and Women are invited to an Ash Wednesday Day of Recollection at Good Counsel Retreat House, Waverly on March 6, 9am-3pm. Cost \$10 and bring a meatless sack lunch. No advance registration. The day includes talks by Fr. Nicholas Kipper, Confessions, Stations, Rosary, Benediction, and Mass with ashes.

**HOW WE STAND** General Fund available funds for operating Church and School = **\$27,764.55** as of 3/1/19. We owe **\$1,517.27** Regular Bills next week, **\$13,500** in payroll next week; and we are behind **\$55,654.45** to the Diocese for our Nov.-Feb. expenses; **Net Deficit = \$42,907.14**. Some or much of that a \$42K deficit will be paid by the matching grant funds when that money comes through. We were \$30,000 behind until the Diocese notified us that we weren't charged correctly for employee health insurance last year; they can do that because each month's bill says it is our responsibility to find mistakes.
