NOTICIAS SOBRE LA NUEVA CONSTRUCCIÓN Hemos recibido regalos grande en apoyo de la nuestra programa de construir un salón parroquial, oficinas de la parroquia y las tres salones de clase. Un grant de \$45,000 dólares desde Flavin Fund Grants y el precio del edificio portable fue \$20,120.00. Todo esto fue añadido a la nuestra cuenta de construcción. El edificio actual que estamos cumpliendo incluye: un salón parroquial con capacidad de 270 personas más alrededor de 30 más sillas en un salón junto hacia la parte sur. La nuestra escuela St. James va a continuar en servir los grados preescolar a 6to. Mil gracias a todo Uds. que han colaborado con el programa de la nueva construcción! El año escolar de 2018-19 comenzara el 20 de agosto 2018. En el futuro nos toca a decidir cuándo vamos a construir una iglesia para remplacer el actual. Rezamos juntos para discernir cuando pasara.

The **PORTABLE ANNEX BUILDING WAS SOLD** for \$20,120.00 and we received a total of \$45,000 from the Bishop Flavin Fund. All proceeds were deposited to our construction account, whose balance should completely cover construction costs. Just to clarify, we are building a parish hall that will seat 270 persons with overflow seating in the south meeting room. The new construction also includes three classrooms for St. James School and our parish CCD program. Our school will continue to serve the same number of grades—preschool to 6th grade. It is up to us all to decide when we will build our future church to replace the current one. Let us pray together to discern when that will be!
