**WHEN SHALL WE BUILD A CHURCH** to replace the one we use now, dedicated 125 years ago on June 11, 1893? That is up to all of us. The plan is to connect our present parish hall with a breezeway to the new church which will be built on the field where the playground and basketball court is right now. As with the new building we just completed, we must first have all funds in hand before construction begins—we cannot borrow such an amount. Our last good estimate for building a new church was in the neighborhood of \$5 million. Many of you continue to contribute towards this and now we have around \$11,000 in that fund. Thank you again to so many of you who sacrificed, gave money and prayed for the success of the project we have just finished!
