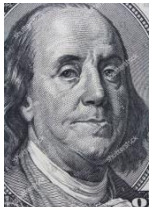

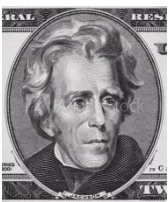

WE ARE GETTING MUCH BETTER We have **\$8,982.97** as of last Friday, October 19th. We owe **\$708.85** for regular bills. We are still behind 3 months (**\$25,746.72** total) to the Diocese assessment, that goes for chancery employee salaries, our property insurance, priests' retirement and health insurance, etc. We pay **\$9,564.58** monthly to School Sisters of Christ the King - due by October 31st; **net deficit of \$27,037.18.**

ALMOST THERE! Our contributions to the Bishop's Appeal for Vocations have nearly reached our parish goal of \$8,640.00—WOW—THANK YOU! The easiest way to give online for BAV is to text "Give \$100" (or another amount) to 531-233-1022. You can also use this for your Charity and Stewardship Appeal contributions—even if you didn't start back in May. We don't get rebates from BAV like we do from *CSA, unless you count Fr. Kaup, Fr. Stoley and Fr. Daro.

WINDING IT DOWN We will use up all of our construction savings that was at the Diocesan Investment and Loan (DIAL) and all of the local construction checking account and the final expenses may run over a bit. However, we have come very close to spending exactly what we thought our project would cost—utterly amazing! This is largely thanks to our architect's accurate estimate and the work of our three Building Committee volunteers who talked daily to the architect and contractor. They are: Dale Korbelik, Jerry Wessel and Norm Pavlish.
