General Fund available funds for operating Church and School = **\$17,187.30** as of 9/14/18. We owe **\$899.13** Regular Bills next week, **\$12,200** Next Friday Payroll Estimate; **\$9,564.58** to School Sisters of Christ the King by Sept. 28th, and **\$25,746.72** to the Diocese for our July, Aug., Sept. expenses, **net deficit = \$31,223.13**. We should get a rebate from Charity and Stewardship Appeal but will need to up our game.
