WINDING IT DOWN We will use up all of our construction savings that was at the Diocesan Investment and Loan (DIAL) and all of the local construction checking account and the final expenses may run over a bit. However, we have come very close to spending exactly what we thought our project would cost—utterly amazing! This is largely thanks to our architect’s accurate estimate and the work of our three Building Committee volunteers who talked daily to the architect and contractor. They are: Dale Korbelik, Jerry Wessel and Norm Pavlish.

General Fund available funds for operating Church and School = **\$9,327.52** as of 9/28/18. We owe **\$331.17** Regular Bills next week; **\$15,000.00** in **by-monthly** payroll this Thursday, 10/4/18. We are behind by **\$25,746.72** to the Diocese for our July, Aug., Sept. assessment. We pay **\$9,564.58** monthly to School Sisters of Christ the King by October 31st, **net deficit = \$-41,314.95.**
