General Fund available funds for operating Church and School = **\$1,534.91** as of 9/7/18 and we owe **\$1,580.80** Regular Bills next week, **\$9,564.58** to School Sisters of Christ the King for Sept., and **\$8,582.24** to the Diocese for our July Expenses, **net deficit = -\$18,192.71**. We aren't overdrawn...yet.

UNBOUND MINISTRY in the Diocese of Lincoln opens our lives to God's grace.
