### WHAT IS A GODPARENT'S JOB?

"This is our faith. This is the faith of the Church. We are proud to profess it, in Christ Jesus our Lord." –from the baptismal rite

At the baptism or confirmation of a person, the godfather or godmother makes a vow before God to help the child grow in the practice of the Catholic faith. The job goes on though, and not just anyone may be a sponsor/godparent. "the godfather and godmother . . . must be firm believers, able and ready to help the newly baptized-child or adult on the road to Christian life. Their task is a truly ecclesial function—a job. The whole ecclesial community bears some responsibility for the development and safeguarding of the grace given at baptism" (The Catechism of the Catholic Church number 1255). Godparents are expected to give good example to their godchildren, remaining publicly and privately faithful to the teachings of the Church.
