*Have I prayed daily? Spent time with my family? Have I been going to Mass on Sundays and holy days? Have I been obedient and respectful to my superiors? Have I lied or deceived others? Have I been arrogant, stubborn or rebellious? Have I been whiny, pouty, moody or selfish? Have I held grudges or refused to forgive others? Have I misused social media to show disrespect, to ridicule or to gossip? Have I used vulgar language or blasphemed God's name? Have I stolen or damaged anything or borrowed without returning it? Have I been helpful and affectionate toward my family? Have I been kind and generous with my spouse? Have I wasted my employer's time? Have I treated employees with respect and dignity? Have I viewed pornography or been unchaste, alone or with another person? Have I taken Holy Communion in a state of mortal sin? Have I neglected my duty to support my parish financially or pretended that what I do give is enough when I know better? Have I doubted God's love and mercy?*
