Dear People of the Parish

Thank you for your support of the Knights of Columbus fireworks sales in past years and we ask for your continued support and prayers for success this year. The revenue generated from this will be used to support various projects in the Parish, St James School and the community. In 2019 the Parish received

almost \$7,000. In 2020 the new Women’s Care Center that will be opened in Lincoln will receive 5% of total sales from the 10 tent locations. The Women’s Care Center (the former Lincoln Right to Life) is located across the street from Planned Parenthood and should reduce the number of abortions by about one third during the first year of operation, and eventually cause the closing of the Planned Parenthood Clinic. Money is being raised for an ultrasound machine.

Volunteer cashiers, baggers, order pickers, and stockers are needed. High school students who need community service hours are encouraged to volunteer. Must be at least 16 years of age.
