**IMPORTANT: Starting Monday, 14 September, we begin to enter Stage 4 of our quarantine recovery. What this means is that all outside venues can go up to 100% capacity if we follow distance protocols, and indoor functions (including religious services) can go up to 75% capacity. We will kind of ease into this over the next week or so, and we will open up church a little more. PLEASE continue to observe distance protocols and remember that you are strongly encouraged to wear a mask, especially if you are in the “danger group.” Thank you and God bless!**

**We will begin having confessions on Wednesday evenings from 6-7pm starting September 23.**

**RCIA will be Sundays from 2-3:15 pm in English and Mondays from 7-8:15pm in Spanish starting the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> of September. They will be held in the meeting room in the parish office and will be live streamed for those who are uncomfortable with coming in person. No registration fees, but we will need numbers in case of cancellations! Classes will go until Easter. A calendar will be provided.**

**We will have a modified Spanish Food Festival.** Every Sunday from 20 September to 11 October, we will have a drive through style opportunity to get food. It will run from 8 am to 2:30 pm. Before Mass, you can place your order and pick it up afterward, or you can just drive up and order your food. You can also call in your order (phone number to be supplied) and pick it up later. We will be selling raffle tickets as well until 3 pm on 11 October. At 4pm on 11 October, we will have a raffle, with three cash prizes and 10 other prizes besides, which will be streamed on Facebook. You do not need to be present to win.

**Keep our First Communion and Confirmation students in your prayers.** Confirmations will be Monday and Friday of this week. They will be open ONLY TO PARENTS, SPONSORS, and THE STUDENTS THEMSELVES. First Communion starts this weekend, and will be every weekend until 11 October at all the Sunday Masses.

**PLEASE REMEMBER** that during school hours masks are required to enter ANY part of the school, which temporarily includes the parish hall. If you are going to attend the daily morning Mass during the school year, we ask you to wear a mask for the sake of consistency and the sake of being an example for the kids, especially since you are all sitting in close proximity to each other. Masks are not required but are strongly encouraged in the parish office.

**Please consider spending an hour with Jesus.** Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place every Friday from 9am-9pm. There needs to be someone in the church at all hours during exposition. Hours that need to be filled are 12-1pm and 7-8pm. Call Donna Havlat (402-826-9475) to volunteer or be on the substitute list. It is great to have more than one person for each hour. May our hours of adoration and prayer bring many graces to our parish and our families.
