As you are all well aware by now, Covid has prevented many from being able to come to Mass. Often times, if one cannot come to Mass, one cannot tithe. We are down nearly 50% in our giving. While we are not in trouble currently, we will be soon. If you have been wanting to give but cannot because you can't leave the house, try online giving. Just scan the QR Code at the top right corner of the page. It is easy to sign up and it can be programmed to be a one-time or recurring gift. Thank you for your stewardship and generosity!

Due to increased Covid cases, the diocese is requiring us to allow no more than 50% capacity in the church for Mass. Remember, however, that the Parish Hall has been open for seating for the past few months. There is plenty of room to spread out, and even if we have 100 people in the Hall, we will still be under 50% capacity. If the church looks pretty full, please make your way to the hall.

The 48th Annual Nebraska Walk for Life will be held on Saturday, January 16, 2021. The outdoor event begins on the north steps of the State Capitol at 10:00 a.m. where there will be speakers and greetings from elected officials.
